Content	This course explores human ethics within educational foundations. It assists students to reflect on their own praxis and experiences to develop humane values of self-determination and selfrealization, and social and individual empowerment. It examines fundamental ontological nature of students and educators' identity, to then deconstruct "social amnesia" of individualism and its effects on collective's "social agency and sociological imaginary" within contexts of postcoloniality in contemporary society. The course addresses the political underpinnings of schooling in a globalizing and postmodern world. Ultimately, it proposes curricular, policy, and transformative pedagogical approaches which enable dialectic/dialogical dynamics for social justice.
